## **Speaker lineup:**

**Friday, January 29: Bill O'Reilly,** a journalist for more than 30 years, is known for hard hitting, uncompromising No Spin reporting and analysis. He is the anchor of the top-rated The O'Reilly Factor and best-selling author.

**Monday, February 22:** Nando Parrado's story remains one of the paramount survival stories of all time. He will share the extraordinary tale of how he and 15 of his teammates survived for 72 brutal days after their plane crashed into the frozen Andes Mountains more than 40 years ago.

**Thursday March 10: Felipe Calderon** was President of Mexico from 2006 to 2012 and made economic reform the top priority of his administration. He implemented policies that catapulted Mexico into a powerful player in the global economy.

**Thursday, March 24: David Petraeus,** is a highly decorated general (U.S. Army, retired) and one of the most prominent combat commanders in American history. He has dedicated his life to public service, leading military campaigns in Iraq and Afghanistan and then serving as the director of the Central Intelligence Agency.
