ELM/EPT

The California State University requires each entering undergraduate, to take the CSU English Placement Test (EPT) and CSU Entry Level Mathematics (ELM) examination prior to registration. They are designed to identify entering students who may need additional support in acquiring college entry-level English and mathematical skills necessary to succeed in CSU baccalaureate-level courses

Study for the EPT/ELM to avoid having to take remedial English and math classes when you get to CSUSB, it is important to study for your placement tests.
